Purpose of this training	Provide future inspectors with as many tools of the trade as possible
Participatory pedagogical approach	A combination of presentations, discussions, plenary sessions, group work and field visits for fictitious inspections on real farms, processing or marketing units.
Deepening the understanding of con- trol procedures	It is a matter of participants understanding exactly what the inspection procedures are - what they should look for, how they should look for it and the importance of making accurate and relevant observations for a report.
The role of the inspector	Accurate observation and reporting rather than recommendations. The trainers will also stress the importance of the inspector's attitudes such as ethics, confidentiality, etc.
